ON-LINE REGISTRATION WILL "CLOSE" AT NOON ON Aug 3, 2016

NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED

Please note --- a "Registration Acceptance Priority" process has been implemented. The large events have been classified as to which category types have acceptance priority (Competitive, Development, Qualifying, Adult and lowest levels first) – see also the Opportunity Chart posted on the WO website.

The HENDERSON competition is considered a **Competitive** event. Should the competition reach skater capacity (as defined by the available ice time) the Technical Representative in consultation with the LOC shall instruct the Registrar to accept only the **COMPETITIVE** entries in priority and withhold all other entries in documented order of receipt until the closing date. Under the direction of the Technical Representative, once a draft schedule has been completed additional entries shall be accepted (in documented order of receipt) until actual limits are reached.

REFUNDS: Entry fees shall be refunded only if a category is not held or if the entry is withdrawn before the closing date
NO REFUNDS WILL BE GIVEN AFTER THE CLOSING DATE OF ENTRIES OF THE COMPETITION - SC Rule 7000 B 1.5(2)."
