Skaters may enter only one category in each of Singles free, STAR 7 or 9, Pairs free, Pattern Dance, Free Dance, Solo Pattern Dance, Interpretive Singles, Interpretive Couples and Element segment **BUT** will be limited to a total of 3 categories at WO Invitational competitions.

Triathlon competitors will **NOT** be allowed to enter any additional Singles free or Interpretive Singles categories at an Invitational competition. However, they may enter **one other** additional category at WO Invitational competitions.

ENTRY & CLOSING DATE INFORMATION

Please be advised that categories / events may close prior to the announced date should the maximum numbers of skaters be reached.

ON-LINE REGISTRATION WILL "OPEN" AT 12:00 NOON ON NOVEMBER 23, 2016

ON-LINE REGISTRATION WILL "CLOSE" AT 12:00 NOON ON DECEMBER 21, 2016

NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED

SILVERTHORNE is considered a **Competitive and Development** priority event. Should the competition reach skater capacity (as defined by the available ice time) the Technical Representative in consultation with the Host committee shall instruct the Registrar to accept the COMPETITIVE and DEVELOPMENT entries in priority and withhold all other entries (in documented order of receipt) until the closing date. Under the direction of the Tech Rep, once a draft schedule has been completed additional entries shall be accepted until actual limits are reached.

REFUNDS: Entry fees shall be refunded only if a category is not held or if the entry is withdrawn before the closing date

NO REFUNDS WILL BE GIVEN AFTER THE CLOSING DATE OF ENTRIES OF THE COMPETITION - SC Rule 7000 B 1.5(2)."

When scheduling, every attempt will be made to avoid conflicts however back to back skates may be necessary. Should conflicts be unavoidable there will be no revisions made to the schedule. Triathlon skaters may be required because of scheduling limitations to skate more than 1 segment of their event on the same day.
