



Clarifications for WO STARSkate Competition – December 7, 2011

1) WO CANSKATE

- a) Must only contain three jumps : Waltz jump, Toe Loop and Salchow
- b) Half Flip, Half Loop, Half Lutz are not permitted. If executed, it will be considered one of the jump elements and given no credit
- c) The following are considered transitional elements and are permitted in the program:
bunny hop, three jump and two foot jump
- d) Any attempt of a spiral will be permitted

2) WO JUNIOR BRONZE LTD

SPINS: The spins for this event should read (see also page 6 of the Skate Canada STARSkate Technical Package):

- Maximum of three spins:
- a) One must be a combination spin with optional change of foot
 - b) One must be a flying spin
 - c) One spin of any nature

3) TRIATHLON categories

The skater **MUST** skate in the highest category that they qualify for

3) INTERPRETIVE categories at WO Invitational events

As per Skate Canada STARSkate Technical package, skaters are not allowed to skate up in the Triathlon and Interpretive categories. Skating up for the FreeSkate categories is allowed. WO will be following this rule at all WO Competitions.

5) WOS STARSKATE CHAMPIONSHIP

For the WO Intro Development levels – please remember that the skater is not allowed to skate in any other freeski discipline if entered in the WO Development program at the WO STARSkate competition.
