



2017 SKATE ONTARIO CHAMPIONSHIPS PRE-SEASON INFORMATION



Skate Ontario has made the following decisions in order to help coaches and skaters prepare for the 2016/17 skating season.

Eligibility to Compete

- (1) **Age Requirements:** Age requirements shall be met before July 1, 2016
- (2) **Test Requirements:** Test Requirements for all skaters shall be met before November 15, 2016.

Events to be offered

Free Skate: STAR 5 U10, U13, 13 & over – three skaters from each section in each age category
STAR 6, STAR 8, STAR 10 and Gold – four skaters from each section plus two wildcards
Pre-Juvenile – four skaters from each section plus two wildcards
Juvenile- four skaters from each section plus two wildcards

Short Programs: STAR 7 and STAR 9 - three skaters from each section. STAR skaters, Pre-Juvenile and Juvenile skaters may register in these short program STAR categories in addition to their free program category.

Triathlon: Bronze, Silver, Gold – three skaters from each section

Dance: STAR 4/5, - three teams from each section
Two dances to be skated: Fiesta Tango and Willow Waltz

Pre-Juvenile – three teams from each section plus three wildcards
Two dances to be skated: Fiesta Tango and Willow Waltz

Juvenile – three teams from each section plus three wildcards
Dances to be skated as per Skate Canada technical package

STAR 6/7, STAR 8/9, STAR 10, Gold, Diamond
Three skaters from each section

Mixed couples only in all dance events
Dances to be skated as per Skate Canada technical package

Pairs: Open Pairs – three teams from each section
 Pre-Juvenile Pairs – three teams from each section

 Juvenile Pairs – three teams from each section

Music Vocal music is permitted for all disciplines

Wildcard Entries: Wildcard entries will be added to each category if the quota per section is not filled.
